



Sliding Doors New at Decorex, Stand F195

The New England Shutter Company will launch its new **motorised tracks** for shutters on sliding tracks at Decorex this Autumn.



Ideal for home cinemas, bedrooms, sitting-rooms, kitchens or as a room divider within open plan living spaces. The **motorised tracks** will smoothly and silently open or close the shutters with the touch of a button on a remote control, even slowing down in the final stages of each movement. Indeed, these are the first automated sliding shutters of their kind.

The New England Shutter Company has spent a number of years carefully researching and developing this exciting new concept. The usual customary attention to detail has been dedicated to this project in order to perfect the design and functionality.

The sliding shutters can be linked into all types of automated systems, incorporating lighting, sound and audiovisual systems within the home if required. They can, for example, be integrated into Lutron home entertainment systems. In a home cinema, one touch on the remote control could therefore dim the lighting, close the shutters and start a film on the big screen – complete with surround sound, of course.

The tracks themselves are set onto the ceiling or boxed in above the shutters making them ultra-discreet, and the shutter panels either stack neatly one behind each other or are entirely concealed within a false wall (depending on the interior design of the room). They can be operated manually if desired, without affecting the programmed settings.

Hand-crafted and made to measure, The New England Shutter Company's automated sliding shutters are available in painted Tulipwood or any other solid natural wood from The New England Shutter Company's collection (including walnut, oak and maple) as well as faux leather or suede.

The ultimate automated sliding shutters, still in development at The New England Shutter Company and due for launch towards the end of 2009, will include a control for tilting the louver blades themselves. This will be operated by a very small motor operated by batteries inside the shutter.
